### **Spirituality at Villanova**

St. Augustine's personal life is profoundly relevant to what our own students face today. As an adolescent, Augustine struggled with life pressures, searched for meaning and purpose, and learned hard lessons from mistakes. Augustine came to realize that creating a community of friends was central to his intellectual and spiritual pursuits; that a shared quest for understanding and truth results in a unity of mind and heart, and ultimately, a relationship with God. This shared journey, or Unity, does not mean uniformity. The diversity of our school community draws us to a mutual respect for differences, and an openness to finding truth in other cultures and religions. Augustine believed that Jesus Christ is the Inner Teacher, enlightening every person, and from whom we can all learn to be happy and fully human.

Our dedicated and caring faculty and staff are companions in our students' spiritual journeys. We integrate the Augustinian core values of **Truth**, **Unity** and **Love** into all aspects of school life. We gather every morning in prayer to celebrate community and friendship. We encourage silent reflection, whether in our chapel, or in the outdoor beauty of our reflection garden. Our Campus Ministry provides opportunities to lead and participate in service projects, retreats, liturgies, and other spiritual activities both on and off campus.

#### **International Baccalaureate Program**

As an International Baccalaureate (IB) World School, we provide our academically motivated students with the unique opportunity to study university-level courses during their junior and senior year with an emphasis on inquiry, knowledge, and caring. As an IB Diploma candidate, you will become globally-minded and discover ways in which you can positively impact the world.

International Baccalaureate courses are offered to Villanova's junior and senior students. Students may choose to take individual IB courses in pursuit of an International Baccalaureate Certificate in that course, or they may pursue the full diploma program.

Students graduating with the full diploma are able to study at universities all over the world, often with advanced credit. These university-level courses in the Diploma Programme will enable our students to be more successful in the university setting through research, writing, critical thinking, time management, and self-confidence.

The Diploma Programme requires students to study six subject groups (three at the standard level and three at the higher level) over two years and complete three additional core requirements: Theory of Knowledge (TOK), the Extended Essay (EE), and Creativity, Activity, and Service (CAS) hours outside of class.
